

MSET Degree Timeline

1. A preliminary **Plan Of Study** should accompany the application. The MSET Program Coordinator will help potential students prepare the initial plan. More information about application can be found at: [Admission](#) and [Apply Online](#).
2. Candidates for the MSET degree must complete a minimum of 32 semester credits. A minimum of 4 credits must be taken from Master's Project, although a greater number of credits may be taken for a project of broader scope. However, no more than 6 credits of Project can be counted toward the degree. More information can be found at [Degree Credits](#) and [Master Projects](#).
3. MSET students should find a project/thesis advisor at least one semester before graduation.
4. Under the supervision of his/her advisor, a MSET student should form a study committee and submit a **Plan Of Work** at least one semester before his/her graduation. More forms are available for download at [Forms](#).
5. A MSET student needs to propose a project topic to his/her study committee and get the proposal approved by the committee.
6. Complete the project and finish the master thesis draft writing. More information about thesis writing and thesis format can be found at: [Project Report Preparing & Writing](#).
7. File a degree application to the graduate school.
8. Two weeks prior to defense, submit the draft of thesis to graduate school for format check.
9. Present the project results and pass the defense. More information about how to deliver a presentation effectively can be found at [Thesis Defense & Presentation](#).
10. Revise the final report thesis based on the comments of committee members if any.
11. Submit the final Thesis manuscript to the Graduate School and revise it as required.
